**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE TOWN OF ROWLAND FOR THE  
REDESIGN AND RECONSTRUCTION OF THE ROWLAND RECREATION  
PARK.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Rowland in Robeson County the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to assist in the redesign and reconstruction of an existing park known as the Rowland Recreational Park, which was developed in the 1940's as a professional baseball park. This refurbished park will assist in preserving the historical character of the surrounding community and provide recreational activities to the citizens of the community and surrounding areas.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
