A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT  
3 AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO ASSIST WITH THE RELOCATION OF  
4 THREATENED STRUCTURES AND TO ACQUIRE COASTAL SHORELINE  
5 PROPERTY RENDERED UNBUILDABLE UNDER CAMA RULES BY BEACH  
6 EROSION.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
9 Environment and Natural Resources the sum of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) for the  
10 1998-99 fiscal year to be allocated as follows:

- 11 (1) \$5,000,000 to be used to assist with the relocation of structures along  
12 the State's shoreline that violate CAMA setback lines.  
13 (2) \$5,000,000 to be used to acquire property that is not "buildable" under  
14 CAMA rules and guidelines as a result of beach erosion.

15 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
