A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION AND THE FINANCING,
2 WITHOUT APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, OF CERTAIN
3 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS OF THE CONSTITUENT
4 INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. The purpose of this act is (i) to authorize the construction by certain
8 constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina and the University of North
9 Carolina General Administration, of the capital improvements projects listed in the act
10 for the respective institutions, and (ii) to authorize the financing of these projects with
11 funds available to the institutions from gifts, grants, receipts, self-liquidating
12 indebtedness, or other funds, or any combination of these funds, but not including funds
13 appropriated from the General Fund.

14 Section 2. The capital improvements projects, and their respective costs,
15 authorized by this act to be constructed and financed as provided in Section 1 of this act,
16 are as follows:

26 Section 3. At the request of the Board of Governors of The University of
27 North Carolina and upon determining that it is in the best interest of the State to do so,
28 the Director of the Budget may authorize an increase or decrease in the cost of, or a
29 change in the method of funding the projects authorized by this act. In determining
30 whether to authorize a change in cost or funding, the Director of the Budget may consult
31 with the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations. In no event may
32 appropriations from the General Fund be used for a project authorized by this act.

33 Section 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
