SENATE BILL 1341

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES AND FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND OTHER ONE-TIME REQUESTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, the sum of one hundred million dollars (\$100,000,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to be allocated as follows:

- (1) \$20,987,788 for Mental Health;
- (2) \$37,820,000 for Developmental Disabilities; and
- (3) \$23,813,918 for Substance Abuse Services.

The remainder of the funds appropriated to the Department under this section shall be used for capital improvements and other one-time requests.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
