**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO ALLOW THE NATIONAL GUARD TO ASSIST THE SPECIAL  
OLYMPICS WITH FUNDS APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF  
CRIME CONTROL AND PUBLIC SAFETY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. If sufficient federal funds are not available, the Governor may use funds appropriated to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety for the 1998-99 fiscal year to activate the North Carolina National Guard from January 1, 1999, to September 30, 1999, to assist with the planning, support, and execution of events associated with the International Special Olympic Games.

Section 2. The Governor may place units or portions of units of the North Carolina National Guard on State Active Duty during the period from January 1, 1999, to September 30, 1999, to assist with the planning, support, and execution of events associated with the International Special Olympic Games.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
