A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE
UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO FUND FULLY THE ENROLLMENT
GROWTH IN THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
Governors of The University of North Carolina for the 2012-2013 fiscal year the sum of
twenty-four million two hundred ninety-four thousand two hundred eighty-seven dollars
(\$24,294,287), of which six million eight hundred fifty-nine thousand four hundred eighty-two
dollars (\$6,859,482) are receipts. The funds appropriated by this act shall be used to fund fully
the requirements for regular term and distance education enrollment growth in the University
System for the 2012-2013 academic year.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2012.
