1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO REPORT ON THE  
3 RESULTS OF FITNESS TESTING IN EACH LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE  
4 UNIT.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-12(37) reads as rewritten:

7 "(37) To Adopt Guidelines for Fitness Testing. – The State Board of Education  
8 shall adopt guidelines for the development and implementation of  
9 evidence-based fitness testing for students statewide in grades kindergarten  
10 through eight. The State Board of Education shall report annually by August  
11 1 to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee on the results of  
12 the testing in each local school administrative unit."

13 **SECTION 2.** The State Board of Education shall report on the results of fitness  
14 testing pursuant to G.S. 115C-12(37) to the Legislative Task Force on Childhood Obesity  
15 annually by August 1 until the Task Force is terminated.

16 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
