A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXCLUDE FROM LICENSURE AS A FACILITY CONSUMERS LIVING IN  
THEIR OWN HOME AND RECEIVING SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 122C-22(a) is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"§ 122C-22. Exclusions from licensure; deemed status.

(a) The following are excluded from the provisions of this Article and are not required  
to obtain licensure under this Article:

...

(12) A home in which up to three adults, two or more having a disability, co-own  
or co-rent a home in which the persons with disabilities are receiving three  
or more hours of day services in the home or up to 24 hours of residential  
services in the home. The individuals who have disabilities cannot be  
required to move if the individuals change services, change service  
providers, or discontinue services."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
