A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO DIRECT THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION, WITH THE
2 ASSISTANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, TO STUDY THE
3 DEVELOPMENT OF NATURAL GAS, OIL, WIND, SOLAR, AND OTHER ENERGY
4 SOURCES CAPABLE OF ENERGY PRODUCTION IN NORTH CAROLINA.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** The Environmental Review Commission, with the assistance of the
8 Department of Commerce, shall study the development of natural gas, oil, wind, solar, and
9 other energy sources capable of energy production for the purposes of North Carolina
10 becoming more self-reliant as to its energy supplies; becoming more independent of foreign
11 energy markets, which are volatile and steeply fluctuating due to current energy and political
12 crises; and avoiding the potential of being completely cut off from foreign fuel due to political
13 unrest and instability in the Middle East. The Commission and the Department shall
14 specifically do all of the following:

- 15 (1) Identify prospective energy companies that explore for and produce energy
16 from natural gas, oil, wind, solar, or other energy sources capable of energy
17 production.
18 (2) Contact the energy exploration and production companies identified and
19 invite these companies to North Carolina to present the Commission and the
20 Department with specific proposals for the production of energy in North
21 Carolina.
22 (3) Consider actions that would promote the development of natural gas, oil,
23 wind, solar, and other energy sources capable of energy production in North
24 Carolina. The Commission and the Department shall specifically consider
25 the use of incentives, including tax credits and other financial incentives, and
26 changes to State law to reduce the regulatory burden on energy development
27 and production in North Carolina.

28 **SECTION 2.** The Commission and the Department shall present their findings,
29 recommendations, and legislative proposals, if any, to the 2012 Regular Session of the 2011
30 General Assembly.

31 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
