 21 **SECTION 4.** G.S. 20-85.1(b) reads as rewritten:
 22 "(b) The Commissioner and the employees of the Division designated by the
 23 Commissioner may prepare and deliver upon request a certificate of title, charging a fee of
 24 ~~seventy five dollars (\$75.00)~~one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for one-day title service, in lieu of
 25 the title fee required by G.S. 20-85(a). The fee for one-day title service must be paid by cash or
 26 by certified check. ~~This Seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) of the assessed fee shall be credited to~~
 27 ~~the Highway Trust Fund. The remainder of any fee collected pursuant to this subsection shall~~

29 (1) The minimum fee for a vehicle licensed under this subsection is twenty-four
 30 dollars (\$24.00) at the farmer rate and ~~twenty-eight dollars~~
 31 ~~(\$28.00)~~ thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) at the general rate. Any fee collected
 32 under this subdivision in excess of twenty-eight (\$28.00) dollars at the
 33 general rate shall be credited to the North Carolina Mobility Fund
 34 established pursuant to G.S. 136-187.

36 (c) The fee for a semitrailer or trailer is ~~nineteen dollars (\$19.00)~~ twenty-five dollars
 37 (\$25.00) for each year or part of a year. The fee is payable each year. Any fee collected in
 38 excess of nineteen dollars (\$19.00) for an annual semitrailer or trailer registration shall be
 39 credited to the North Carolina Mobility Fund established pursuant to G.S. 136-187. Upon the
 40 application of the owner of a semitrailer or trailer, the Division may issue a multiyear plate and
 41 registration card for the semitrailer or trailer for a fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00). A
 42 multiyear plate and registration card for a semitrailer or trailer are valid until the owner
 43 transfers the semitrailer or trailer to another person or surrenders the plate and registration card
 44 to the Division. A multiyear plate may not be transferred to another vehicle.

45 The Division shall issue a multiyear semitrailer or trailer plate in a different color than an
 46 annual semitrailer or trailer plate and shall include the word "multiyear" on the plate. The
 47 Division may not issue a multiyear plate for a house trailer.
