Short Title: Adjust Quarterly Reporting. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO ADJUST THE CALENDAR PERIODS COVERED BY QUARTERLY  
3 REPORTS OF CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENDITURES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 163-278.9(a)(5a) reads as rewritten:

6 "(5a) Quarterly Reports. – During even-numbered years during which there is an  
7 election for that candidate or in which the campaign committee is supporting  
8 or opposing a candidate, the treasurer shall file a report by mailing or  
9 otherwise delivering it to the Board no later than seven working days after  
10 the end of each calendar quarter covering the prior calendar quarter, except  
11 that:

12 a. The report for the first quarter shall also cover the period in April  
13 through the seventeenth day before the primary, the first quarter  
14 report shall be due seven days after that date, and the second quarter  
15 report shall not include that period if a first quarter report was  
16 required to be ~~filed, and~~ filed.

17 b. The report for the third quarter shall also cover the period in October  
18 through the seventeenth day before the election, the third quarter  
19 report shall be due seven days after that date, and the fourth quarter  
20 report shall not include that period if a third quarter report was  
21 required to be filed.

22 c. The report for the fourth quarter shall also cover the month of  
23 January after the election, and the next required report shall not cover  
24 that period if a fourth quarter report was required to be filed."

25 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2012, and applies to reports  
26 covering calendar periods occurring after that date.
