**SESSION LAW 2018-20  
HOUSE BILL 1027**

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A VIOLATION OF THE NO-WAKE SPEED ZONE UPON THE WATERS WITHIN THE COMMUNITY OF THE VILLAGE OF BALD HEAD ISLAND IS AN INFRACTION AND THAT A VIOLATION IS ENFORCEABLE AS IF IT WERE A PROVISION OF THE GENERAL LAWS REGULATING BOATING SAFETY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 2.1 of Chapter 688 of the Session Laws of 1987 reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 2.1. Any person who violates this act ~~shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be subject to a fine not to exceed two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00)~~ is responsible for an infraction as provided in G.S. 14-3.1 and shall pay a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00). A person responsible for an infraction under this act shall not be assessed court costs."

**SECTION 2.** Section 3 of Chapter 688 of the Session Laws of 1987 reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 3. This law ~~shall be enforced by officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, and by the Brunswick County Sheriff~~ act is enforceable under G.S. 75A-17 as if it were a provision of Chapter 75A of the General Statutes."

**SECTION 3.** This act applies to the Village of Bald Head Island only.

**SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
