Short Title: Funds for Madison County/Hurricane Helene. (Public) Representative Pless. Sponsors: Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR VARIOUS REPAIRS NEEDED IN MADISON COUNTY AS A RESULT OF HURRICANE HELENE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State Budget and Management the sum of eighty-eight million three hundred ninety-five thousand dollars (\$88,395,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2025-2026 fiscal year to provide a directed grant to Madison County to be used as follows: Twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000) for repairs at the Marshall (1) Wastewater Treatment Plant. (2) Six million dollars (\$6,000,000) for repairs to the Marshall Town Hall. One million six hundred thousand dollars (\$1,600,000) to rebuild the Marshall (3) Housing Authority Apartments. One million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for repairs to the (4) Marshall Volunteer Fire Department. Four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for repairs to the Hot Springs Town (5) Twelve million dollars (\$12,000,000) to build a new facility for the Hot (6) Springs Wastewater Treatment Plant. Six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for repairs to the Hot Springs (7) Community Center. Two hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$270,000) for repairs to the Hot (8) Springs Library. Three million dollars (\$3,000,000) for temporary relocation of Town (9) departments housed in the Sprinkle Shelton Building. Four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for repairs to Barnard Park. (10)Two hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$225,000) for repairs to the Hot (11)Springs Housing Authority Wastewater Treatment Facility. Twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000) for repairs to the French Broad (12)River, Ivy River, and Additional County Tributaries and Waterways, including debris removal. Four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for repairs to the County's (13)Communications Tower at Duckett Top. Nine hundred thousand dollars (\$900,000) to complete the upgrades to the NC (14)
