Definitions and general consideration. 9 For the purpose of this Article: 10 (6) 11 The term "drug" means Articles recognized in the official United States Pharmacopoeia, 12 13 official Homeopathic Pharmacopoeia of the United States, or official National Formulary, or any supplement to any of them; and 14 Articles intended for use in the diagnosis, cure, mitigation, treatment 15 b. or prevention of disease in man or other animals; and 16 Articles (other than food) intended to affect the structure or any 17 c. function of the body of man or other animals; and 18 Articles intended for use as a component of any article specified in 19 d. 20 paragraphs a, b or c; but does not include devices or their components, parts, or accessories. 21 22 Food that contains a vaccine or vaccine material. <u>e.</u> 23 24 (14g) The term "vaccine or vaccine material" means a substance intended to 25 stimulate the production of antibodies and provide immunity against disease 26 that is (i) prepared from the causative agent of a disease, its products, or a 27 synthetic substitute to act as an antigen without inducing the disease and (ii) authorized or approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration 28 for use in humans. 29 30 31 32 PART II.
