HOUSE BILL DRH30197-NE-43A

Short Title: State ID Cards for High School Students. (Public)

Sponsors: Representative Pickett.

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO ALLOW NORTH CAROLINA RESIDENTS WHO ARE AT LEAST SIXTEEN  
3 YEARS OF AGE TO OBTAIN A NORTH CAROLINA SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION  
4 CARD FOR A FEE AND TO ESTABLISH A PILOT PROGRAM TO ISSUE SPECIAL  
5 IDENTIFICATION CARDS TO STUDENTS IN PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS IN  
6 MECKLENBURG, RANDOLPH, UNION, AND WATAUGA COUNTIES.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-37.7(d) reads as rewritten:

9 "(d) Expiration and Fee. – A special identification card issued to a person for the first time  
10 under this section expires when a drivers license issued on the same day to that person would  
11 expire. A special identification card renewed under this section expires when a drivers license  
12 renewed by the card holder on the same day would expire. The Division shall offer renewal of a  
13 special identification card in person and online on the Division's Web site.

14 The fee for a special identification card is the same as the fee set in G.S. 20-14 for a duplicate  
15 license. The fee does not apply to a special identification card issued to a resident of this State as  
16 follows:

17 ...  
18 (2) The applicant is at least ~~17~~16 years old.  
19 ...."

20 **SECTION 2.(a)** Establishment of Pilot Program. – By no later than December 31,  
21 2025, the Division of Motor Vehicles of the Department of Transportation (DMV), in  
22 conjunction with the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction (DPI) and the governing  
23 bodies of public school units with high schools located in Mecklenburg, Randolph, Union, and  
24 Watauga Counties, shall establish and implement a pilot program to issue a North Carolina  
25 special identification card as provided under G.S. 20-37.7 to eligible students in public high  
26 schools.

27 **SECTION 2.(b)** Pilot Program Requirements. – The pilot program established  
28 pursuant to this act shall, at minimum, meet all of the following requirements:

- 29 (1) Students that are (i) at least 16 years old and (ii) enrolled in a public high  
30 school located within Mecklenburg, Randolph, Union, or Watauga County  
31 shall be eligible to receive a special identification card.  
32 (2) DMV, DPI, and the governing bodies of public high schools located in  
33 Mecklenburg, Randolph, Union, and Watauga Counties shall provide  
34 information to students and parents regarding the issuance of special  
35 identification cards.



- 1 (3) DMV, DPI, and the governing bodies of public high schools located in  
2 Mecklenburg, Randolph, Union, and Watauga Counties shall coordinate  
3 scheduled time to give students the opportunity to obtain special identification  
4 cards. Time to obtain a special identification card shall be scheduled on one  
5 instructional day prior to December 31 of that school year and one  
6 instructional day after December 31 of that school year. If students travel to a  
7 DMV location to obtain the special identification card, the DMV shall have a  
8 dedicated terminal for students during that time. A DMV mobile office may  
9 also be used to satisfy this requirement.
- 10 (4) Upon the request of a student, the student's high school shall provide the DMV  
11 with the information required to complete a special identification card  
12 application. This information shall be provided in a manner prescribed by the  
13 DMV.
- 14 (5) Notwithstanding G.S. 130A-93 or any other law to the contrary, the State  
15 Registrar is authorized to issue a certified copy of a student's birth certificate  
16 to the governing body of a public high school or the Division upon a student's  
17 request in connection with a special identification card application. The  
18 certified copy of the student's birth certificate is not a public record.

19 **SECTION 2.(c)** Expiration of the Pilot Program. – The pilot program required by  
20 this act expires December 31, 2027.

21 **SECTION 3.** Applicability. – Section 2 of this act applies to public high schools  
22 located in Mecklenburg, Randolph, Union, and Watauga Counties only.

23 **SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
