Short Title: Funds for Various Projects in Cabarrus Co. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR VARIOUS PROJECTS IN THE TOWNS OF
3 MIDLAND AND HARRISBURG.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State
6 Budget and Management the sum of seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) in nonrecurring funds
7 for the 2025-2026 fiscal year to provide a directed grant to the Town of Midland for various road
8 improvements in the Bethel Glen Development and the Tucker Chase Development.

9 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State
10 Budget and Management the sum of twelve million seven hundred thousand dollars
11 (\$12,700,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2025-2026 fiscal year to provide a directed grant to
12 the Town of Harrisburg to be used as follows:

13 (1) Two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) for turf fields.

14 (2) Nine million two hundred thousand dollars (\$9,200,000) for the Harrisburg
15 passenger rail station.

16 (3) One million dollars (\$1,000,000) to complete the Harrisburg YMCA building.

17 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State
18 Budget and Management the sum of one million nine hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,950,000)
19 in nonrecurring funds for the 2025-2026 fiscal year to provide a directed grant to Cabarrus
20 County to be used for Cabarrus Rowan Community Health Center to expand and sustain access
21 to care in the County.

22 **SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State
23 Budget and Management the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for
24 the 2025-2026 fiscal year to provide a directed grant to Cabarrus Cooperative Christian Ministry,
25 Inc., a nonprofit organization, to assist members of the community experiencing crisis in the
26 areas of food, housing, or finances.

27 **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2025.
