Sponsors: Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF PUBLIC HEALTH, TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO NONPROFIT COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTERS FOR THE PURCHASE AND DISTRIBUTION OF LONG-ACTING REVERSIBLE CONTRACEPTIVES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) in recurring funds for each year of the 2025-2027 fiscal biennium to be used to award grants on a competitive basis to nonprofit community health centers. Nonprofit community health centers selected to receive these grant funds shall use all such funds to purchase and make available long-acting reversible contraceptives for underserved, uninsured, or medically indigent patients. As used in this section, the term "long-acting reversible contraceptives" means a contraceptive drug or device that meets all of the following criteria: Is a method of birth control that provides effective contraception for an (1) extended period of time without depending upon user action.
