Whereas, children represent the future and embody the hopes and aspirations of the people of North Carolina; and Whereas, investing in the health, education, and well-being of our children is paramount to ensuring a prosperous and sustainable society; and Whereas, recognizing the importance of nurturing and protecting our children encourages communities, families, and organizations to collaborate in creating safe and supportive environments; and Whereas, celebrating Children's Day provides an opportunity to acknowledge the achievements and potential of all children, regardless of their background or circumstances; and Whereas, such a day serves to raise awareness about the challenges and issues facing children today, including access to quality education, healthcare, and opportunities for personal growth; and Whereas, the State of North Carolina is committed to promoting policies and initiatives that support the development and well-being of its youngest residents; Now, therefore, The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Chapter 103 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:
