SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-12(21) reads as rewritten:

	<u>a.</u>	The State Board shall adopt standard definitions for acts	
		violence and shall require local boards of education to re-	eport them
		within five days of the act occurring to the State Board in	$a\ standard$
		format adopted by the State Board. The State Board shall re	equire local
		boards of education to specify in their reports if an act of	of violence
		occurred on a school bus and the State Board shall include	this data in
		the reports required under this subdivision. Failure of an en	mployee of
		a local school administrative unit or a member of a local	al board of
		education to make a report to the State Board as requir	ed by this
		sub-subdivision is a Class I felony.	
	<u>b.</u>	The State Board shall submit its report on acts of violence in	the public
		schools to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Spe	eaker of the
		House of Representatives, and the Joint Legislative	Education
		Oversight Committee by March 15 of each year at the	end of the
		second and fourth quarters of each school year.	
	<u>c.</u>	Reports submitted pursuant to this subdivision are pub	lic record,
		except that any sensitive identifying information from the	report shall
		be redacted for the privacy of minors."
