SECTION 1. Effective July 1, 2025, there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Reserve for Compensation Increases to provide pay raises for the State Highway Patrol the sum of forty million four hundred eighty-two thousand four hundred eighty dollars (\$40,482,480) in each year of the 2025-2027 fiscal biennium to establish the pay scales set forth in this act.

SECTION 2. Effective July 1, 2025, the law enforcement officers of the State Highway Patrol shall be paid based upon the following experience-based annual salary schedule:

SECTION 3. Effective July 1, 2025, Sworn State Highway Patrol employees who are not subject to an experience-based annual salary schedule shall be paid at the following rates by rank:
